





International Award "Trieste - Right to dialogue" 2nd Edition

Applications must be received by the Organization Office at the address <u>dialogoaward@gmail.com</u> not later than 28th February 2020.

1. Genesis and Purpose of the Award

The International Award "Trieste - Right to Dialogue" is promoted by the **Associazione Poesia e Solidarietà**, in collaboration with the **International Study and Documentation Centre for Youth Culture (iSDC)**. It originated as part of the annual **World Youth Forum "Right to Dialogue"**, and is now awarded on the occasion of the forthcoming Poetry and Literature Festival, to be held in Trieste, Italy, from 21-30 March 2020.

The Award supports the purpose of the Forum which intends to affirm the "right to dialogue" as a fundamental right, and is divided into two sections:

SECTION A)

Any citizen from any country and citizenship (European and non-European), regardless of age or profession, can indicate for the awarding of the Prize a high-profile international candidate who has contributed and contributes to the affirmation of the culture of dialogue in any field of their work, research, artistic expression, social commitment.

Self-applications will not be accepted.

The application to nominate a personality for the award must include the following elements:

- 1) Full indication of the candidate's personal and biographical data, any affiliations, website, contact information and other data useful to know candidate's personality.
- 2) The Candidate's Curriculum Vitae highlighting his/her qualifications that make him/her worthy of the award as particularly linked to the promotion of the culture of dialogue.
- 3) Curriculum Vitae of the person who submits the application.
- 4) Full and clear motivation by which the person who submits the application justifies his/her proposal.

The award-winning personality will receive a prize of € 1,000 and will be invited to Trieste during the Poetry and Literature Festival 2020 (March 21-30).

SECTION B)

Applicants within this section are young scholars **up to 35 years old** (Italian, European or non-European) who authored a work (published or unpublished) whose focus is represented by the "dialogic" question in all

its possible manifestations (from philosophical-linguistic, historical and cultural-historical aspects to international dialogue, intercultural or interreligious dialogue, in generational or gender issues ...).

Self-applications are accepted.

The application must include:

- 1) The applicant's personal data
- 2) The applicant's Curriculum Vitae highlighting the aspects considered consistent with the purpose of the award
- 3) A copy of the work that is proposed to obtain the award must be attached to the application. In case of a published work, it can be sent by snail mail (on the same day the application is sent by email, the postmark serving as a proof: in any case the work must not arrive after the deadline of the competition) or in Publisher's version PDF attached to the application sent by email; in case of unpublished work, it can be sent in PDF format attached to the application sent by email.

The selected young scholar will be awarded visibility and possible publication of his/her work by an evaluation committee made up of prominent experts in different scientific and artistic fields, and will be invited to Trieste to present his/her work.
